The Support4Sport Program was introduced by the Nova Scotia Provincial Lotteries and Casino Corporation in 2006. Funds are raised through the sale of designated lottery products. Each time one of those products is sold, 100 per cent of the proceeds help Nova Scotians get in the game. Since its inception, the program has helped raise over \$34 million for amateur sport in Nova Scotia and is the province’s largest funder of sport, helping athletes go from playground to podium.
